VOTING MADE SIMPLE



A Sign the Voting Receipt and get your ballot.

Sign the Voting Receipt (Form 1) and get your ballot (Form 2) from the Election Officer. The ballot is to be used to mark your vote.

B Ballots are lifted by slitting the seal and using thumbtack to mark conditions.



C Complete the ballot by marking your vote.

Mark your vote by putting an 'X' on the ballot. The 'X' should be made in the box of the candidate you want to elect.

After the election, the ballot is to be put in the ballot box. The ballot box is to be sealed by the Election Officer.

Fast and Easy as 1-2-3

COUNTING MADE FAST AND EASY



1 Ballots will be transported to a centralized counting station.

The ballot is to be put in a separate bag, and the bag is to be sealed.



2 Ballots will be read by the vote counting machine.



3 Election results are known immediately.

The vote counting machine is to be used to count the votes. The results are to be known immediately.
